



Meredith's Holiday Decorating Tips

1. A low stack or grouping of small wrapped packages makes for a festive centerpiece. Choose 2 – 3 coordinating artisan papers for visual appeal. These packages could also contain a small token or favor for each guest to take away at the end of the evening. Adding personalized name tags to each package is a thoughtful gesture that is sure to make each guest feel special.
2. Small bud vases of varying heights and napkin rings are a creative way to display large ornaments as a centerpiece.
3. Embellish a table scape by incorporating fresh botanicals on each package and ornament. This is an interesting way of changing up the traditional floral centerpiece arrangement. Fresh floral or botanicals are lovely add-ons to make the favor gifts even more special.
4. Fresh sprigs of holiday greenery placed around the base of each dinner plate create a unique charger or place mat.
5. Integrating beautiful holiday candy is another way to create a festive holiday table. Create a post-dinner candy cocktail by filling champagne glasses with peppermint candies. Large scale handmade candy canes or ribbon candy is another lovely way to embellish the table top centerpiece.
